## Total Solutions in Controlled Hydraulic Movement and Jacking

Resolving subsidence on the old Seager Gin Distillery in Deptford Creek, London, as part of The Distillery Crescent major redevelopment consisting of luxury apartments, shops, restaurant and offices.

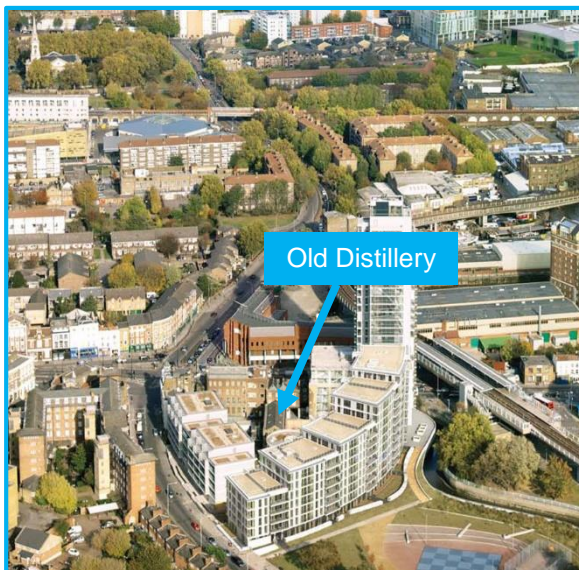

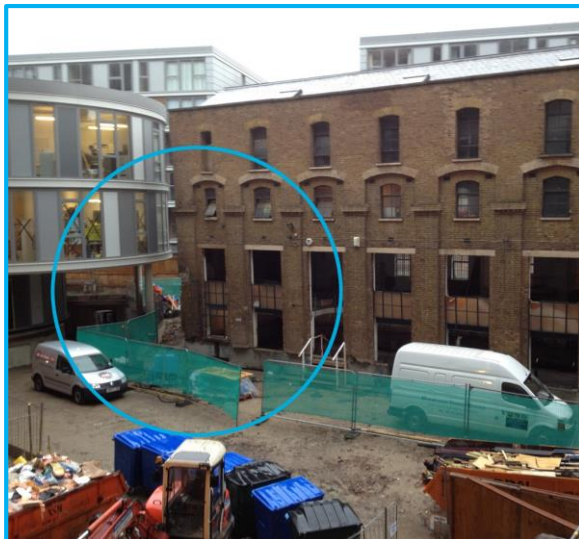


### Project Challenge

To carefully jack up the corner of the old distillery building by 150 mm. O'Shea contractors had installed a concrete ring beam at the base of the building with reinforced gaps for the jacks. The work had to be completed in one day.

### Bill Boley Solution

14 off 80 tonne standard lift compression jacks were used to carefully lift the corner of the building (Highlighted in blue opposite). The applied jacking loads were continually monitored, whilst structural engineers checked the building structure. Ensuring even jacking is vital in such a project involving very high loading.
